<sup>1</sup> *Relational Bullying* is a type of aggression in which harm is caused by damaging someone's relationships or social status (includes forms of ostracism, put-downs, cyber-bullying). <sup>2</sup> **UNESCO Definition of bullying; "A person is bullied when he or she is exposed, repeatedly and over time, to negative actions on the part of one or more other persons, and he or she has difficulty defending himself or herself." (Dan Olweus)** This definition includes three important components: 1. Bullying is aggressive behavior that involves unwanted, negative actions. 2. Bullying involves a pattern of behavior repeated over time. 3. Bullying involves an imbalance of power or strength.

<sup>3</sup> Saturday school detention fees of 1000 Dhs/per Saturday are responsibility of the parents. Saturday school is from 8:00AM-1:00PM. Not arriving on time and not adhering to rules, will result in a subsequent Saturday school detention and/or out-of-school suspension of 5-10 days. <sup>4</sup> In-school & out-of-school Suspension result in a maximum grade of 85% on assignments during suspension.

<sup>5</sup> An accumulation of 15 Demerits results in a Probation Contract for Re-enrollment for subsequent school year. Level D Infraction and/or twenty-five Demerits result in Expulsion Hearing.
