MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Machine Type: Laptop or Hybrid OS Windows 7 / Mac OS X
- Screen Size 13.5"
- Processor Intel Core M / I5RAM 4 GB (recommend 8GB)
- Storage 300-500 GB *
- Wi-Fi 802.11g Ports 2 USB, Audio in/out, VGA or HDMI Battery 4 cell
Warranty 1 year (new equipment)
- 802.11a/b/g/n wireless network adapter (802.11ac if available on laptop model)
- Built in microphone/camera



REQUIRED SOFTWARE

- Microsoft Office or equivalent Open Source Office Suite (free)
- Adobe Flash (free)
- Adobe Shockwave (free)
- Java (free)
- Video editing software Lightworks (free), Adobe Premier, or iMovies

- GIMP 2.8 (free), Adobe Photoshop, or similar graphics editor.
- Audacity (free, sound editing)
- Anti-virus/malware protection, Windows and Mac
